## 7th-12th grade FoFCA Community Service Hours

What activities constitute community service? Community service is any activity in which a student is assisting someone in their community (church, school, neighborhood, food pantry etc) for the betterment of themselves and others. This means the student is NOT receiving payment for their services. Additionally, housework or babysitting siblings/relatives is not community service.

Community service helps students think outside themselves and have compassion for others. In a society in which many young people are self-centered and unsatisfied, it is important to FOFCA to promote this aspect of their education. Clearly the Bible teaches that Jesus lived his life as servants to others. Being God He took on the form of a servant (Phil 2.7). Because the goal of a Christ-follower is to emulate Him in word and actions, we believe this is just one tool that students can use to fulfil this goal.

- All 7th-12th graders are required to serve in their community as a volunteer for at least four hours.
- This can be done in one place, all in one day, or spread out in various time increments as long as you end up with four hours.
- This form must be signed by an adult supervisor(s).
- Turn this form in the first day of school to your Bible teacher.
